We will be meeting at the **Doubletree Hotel in Scottsdale** in what they call the Chaparral room. **Registration will begin at 4:00 pm Tuesday afternoon** and close at 5:30 pm. The program begins at 6pm.

### **Hotel**

We have a great deal at the **Clarion Hotel** just a few hundred yards away from the Doubletree (\$40.00 a night/double occupancy). For **reservations with the discounted rate, please CALL** toll free: (866) 394-3911 or (480) 945-4392 and tell them you are with the ISFM.

### **Airport Pickup**

**For your convenience, we will be providing free transportation from the Phoenix airport ([map](#)) to the conference on Tuesday at specific times: 10:30 am, 12 Noon, 2:00 pm, 4:00 pm, and 5:30 pm.** Pick up will be at **Terminal 3**, first floor, north curb, outside door 7 (see link to maps).
